Air France awards in-flight connectivity solution to Global Eagle and Orange Business Services for Airbus A320 family aircraft

Global Eagle Entertainment Inc. (NASDAQ: ENT) announced that Air France has awarded a long-term contract for in-flight connectivity systems and services to a collaboration between Global Eagle and Orange Business Services.

The contract initially includes 113 Airbus A320 family aircraft operated by Air France. Installations are already underway. Air France's Airbus A320 family includes A318, A319, A320 and A321 aircraft that operate short and medium-haul flights throughout Europe, Russia, North Africa and the Middle East.
